In order to be considered for the Jersey City Scholarship, you must be a resident of Jersey City.

Residency Definition:

You are considered a resident of Jersey City if any of the following applies:

- ❖ Applicant has to be a legal resident of Jersey City for at least a year
- ❖ Applicant is a college student who is a Jersey City resident and moved out of the city only for the specific purpose of going away to college

AWARDS

Scholarships of \$500 will be awarded for undergraduate study only.

SELECTION

The Scholarship Fund is administered entirely by Sidewalk University. Final selection of recipients is made by Sidewalk University. Sidewalk University will determine and announce scholarship recipients on the fourth Saturday in July at the Jersey City Carnival Scholarship Breakfast each year.

PAYMENT OF AWARDS

The scholarship winner must be in attendance at the Jersey City Carnival Scholarship Breakfast.

RESPONSIBILITIES

Applicants are responsible for the admission to an accredited college or university and for meeting its entrance requirements. Applicants are also responsible for gathering and submitting to Sidewalk University the information necessary for selecting Scholarship Funds recipients as outlined above.

- Provide the committee with your high school or College/University transcript mailed directly from your school.
- Have confirmed plans to attend a college or university of higher learning to further your education.
- Provide two references, including names, addresses and telephone numbers. One must be a personal reference and one must be a school reference.
- Provide information on your interests, hobbies, school, and community activities, including any volunteer work.
- Submit a typewritten research paper of from 500 to 750 words. The topic selected must be about education. Footnotes and a bibliography of your references are to be included. This paper should be prefaced by a short paragraph explaining why you are applying for this scholarship. All papers submitted become the property of The Sidewalk University, Inc.
- Your application must be received by July 1st.



The committee will review each application on the basis of information submitted in accordance with the prior items. The scholarship will be presented at the Jersey City Carnival Scholarship Breakfast held the fourth Saturday in July.

Note: The exact amount of scholarships awarded will depend on the funds available.
